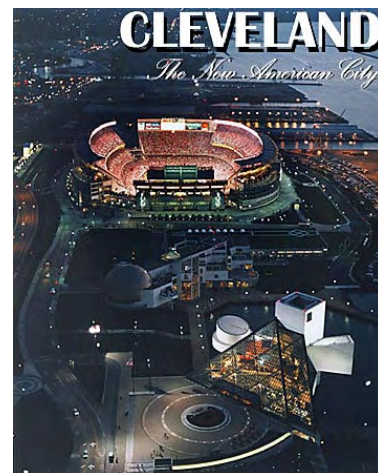

So, What Time Does the 7:00 P.M. Contest Session Start?

Surprising as it may seem, I have actually heard this question many times during my tenure as Events VP, and it is a fair question to ask. I usually hear it after someone has missed a significant pre-session activity, like the mic tester quartet, because they showed up right smack dab at the announced session start time.



Therefore, I thought I'd take this opportunity on the eve of a wonderful District Convention in Independence, Ohio, to shed a little light on the subject. When we print a start time in a convention program, it is the time at which the first competitor will appear on stage. There are, however, many things that happen before that first competitor

takes the stage. For instance, someone usually introduces the MC for the session and that occurs about 10 to 15 minutes prior to the posted start time.

The MC has some rules that the C&J folks and Society require be presented to the attendees. OK, so you've heard them and don't think you need to hear them again? Well, many MCs have added some of their own so that the reading of the rules isn't necessarily the same old thing, and you might find the additional "rules" entertaining. I well remember hearing an MC a few years ago admonish the crowd that, in addition to the contest rules, there would be no running in the auditorium with a pencil in one's hand, and that no one would be permitted to enter the water in the auditorium until they had digested their food for a half hour. See what you missed by not getting there a few minutes early? In addition, some MCs use that first few minutes to "bond" with



their audience. How do you know when to boo or award catcalls to the MC if you haven't participated in the "pre-game" warm-up, particularly with the all-star cast we have lined up this year in Dan Trakas, Ev Nau, and Bill Biffle.

Another "extra" that can occur (and in the case of the convention in Independence, will occur) is added activities. At District this year in Independence, for example, there will be two mic tester quartets. We will have the traditional mic tester quartet who earned



the right to mic test based on Divisional qualifying score. That quartet is Independence's own "High Five," and if you want to hear them mic test, you'll need to be in your seat well prior to the 7 p.m. start time in the program. A second mic tester quartet is a brand new quartet that includes former JAD District Champion bass Dave Jarrell and the tenor of the 2004 International Champion Gotcha!, Garry Texiera. On Saturday night, we have a men's youth choir and a men's quartet from one of the local high schools that will each perform prior to the introduction of the Finals mic tester quartet, and all of that will happen immediately prior to the posted Finals start time.

In summary, see what you miss if you show up at the printed start time? You'll miss a whole lot of action that you really don't wanna miss, so get in your seats 20 minutes to a half hour before the posted start time! You'll be glad you did!



Finding Your Way in Independence, Ohio

We'll be rolling out the red carpet October 20 and 21, 2006, and welcoming all competing quartets and choruses, families, friends, and fans, to beautiful Independence, Ohio.

In order to make your contest experience top-notch, we've arranged a quick commute from hotels to contest venue! All our recommended hotels are located off Rockside Road;
allow approximately 15 minutes travel time from your hotel to the contest venue!

(Quarry Lane pertains to Doubletree and Comfort Inn only. The Holiday Inn is on Rockside directly across from Quarry Lane and requires a right hand turn onto Rockside)

2.	Turn L on ROCKSIDE RD - go 2.0 mi	
3.	ROCKSIDE RD becomes SNOW RD - go 1.9 mi	
4.	Turn L on W 54TH ST - go 0.8 mi	
5.	Arrive at 6285 W 54TH ST, PARMA , on the L	

The school uses West 54th St. as its address, but parking is accessed from Longwood.

An 80-spot parking lot will be clearly designated for "JAD Events Team and Competitors Only" at the southeast corner of Longwood and West 54th with immediate access to ready rooms and auditorium. A huge parking lot is available behind the school off of Longwood for all other attendees - allow 6 to 8 minutes to walk from your car to the auditorium.

Coming to the 2006 JAD District Convention in Independence? Bring the family! There's lots to do in the area.

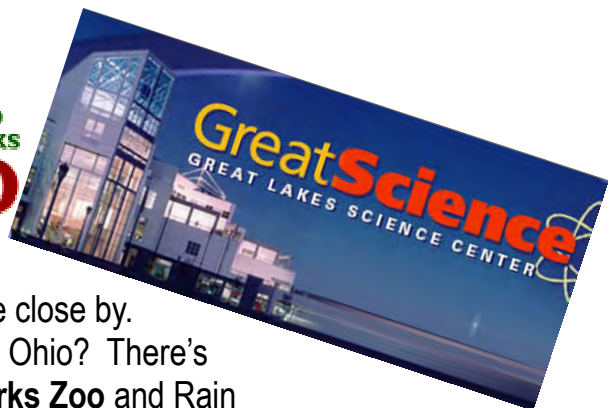

Dining



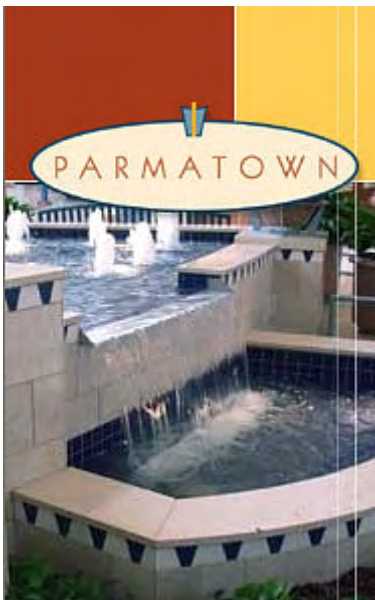


